### **Our Path Forward**

**Discern:** September to December 2025—What is God calling us to accomplish in a proposed capital campaign?

**Study:** January to March 2026—Only if the discernment phase guides us to do so, we will conduct a feasibility study to determine priorities and gauge potential financial support.

**Ask:** April to June 2026—Only if a feasibility study indicates support, we will move ahead with a capital campaign.

### Areas of Need to Help St. Clare's Grow and Thrive

These four areas of need are currently under discussion for potential funding through a proposed St. Clare's capital campaign. No final decisions have been made and your ideas are welcome.

#### Building repair and maintenance

We are responsible for half of the capital expenses to maintain our joint Genesis facilities. Many of our mechanical systems are reaching the end of their useful life and need to be replaced or upgraded soon. Our operating budget and our reserve funds are inadequate to cover these upcoming expenses.

#### **Grow the Ark Fund for capital projects**

If we can increase the amount we have in our reserve fund for capital expenses, we could generate more income to cover our share of the annual Genesis capital assessment and avoid spending down our operational funds, leaving more to support our mission.

### Fund St. Clare's staffing and program needs

St. Clare's has been the beneficiary of a grant to cover the majority of Rev. Toby's curacy, which will end in 2027. Returning to our previous staffing level will make it difficult to sustain our current level of programming and growth. A proposed capital campaign could be used to fund an additional staff position while we continue to grow our annual operating income.

#### Expand outreach initiatives to those who are vulnerable and underserved

Given the increasing needs in our community, we are discerning how we can fund increased outreach initiatives that meet the needs of the most vulnerable and underserved. A proposed capital campaign could generate revenue for new outreach initiatives.

We hope every member of the congregation will participate in this discernment.
